### **Sharing Information**

Now that Gridcheck is up and running in almost all Judicial Districts (19 out of 22), I have a better way to gather and use pertinent information from service providers in the field. I depend on you tell me anything that you feel is important to share regarding the provision of effective services. Of course, I am not looking for case related or personal information about clients, but please share information about communication or court needs that could help you or another service provider that comes in later. There is no "one-size-fits-all" formula for the provision of services and to serve our clients well (the deaf and hard of hearing and the courts), some information must be shared. The most obvious example is the need for a deaf interpreter or a team, but there are also unique situations that arise that require unique services and I have no way to know about them if I am not kept informed by you or the court. The best way to let me know is a quick email so I can copy and paste the information into the job 'Notes' in Gridcheck. I am always open for other suggestions to improve services and the program so let me know your thoughts!
