Thank you all (or most of you) for submitting the paperwork for 2017 and for understanding and complying with the new insurance requirements. Your extra time and attention is greatly appreciated.

New Mileage Rate

Don't forget that the mileage rate for 2017 is down to \$.48 per mile. Mandy changed it in Gridcheck but please keep an eye on your invoices during January to make sure that the rate is showing up as \$.48 instead of \$.49.

Service Provider Recruitment

If you have colleagues that are RID Certified and who would like to become independent contractors for CCDHH, please have them get in touch with us as soon as possible. Status IV interpreters do not have to be legally qualified and can be assigned to non-court and non-legal settings, such as for court ordered treatment and for our CCDHH staff needs. We are adding an additional program to CCDHH which will provide services to the deaf-blind as well so the "in-house" need for interpreters will be increasing. On this subject, please let us know if you have experience and are comfortable interpreting for deaf-blind individuals.

Standard Operating Procedures (SOP's)

We have begun work on the SOP's and will be sharing initial draft to seek feedback on various topics. Stay tuned, we look forward to the involvement and input from all of our stakeholder communities. We are excited and look forward to this collaborative effort. This project will be a big focus of our work in 2017.
