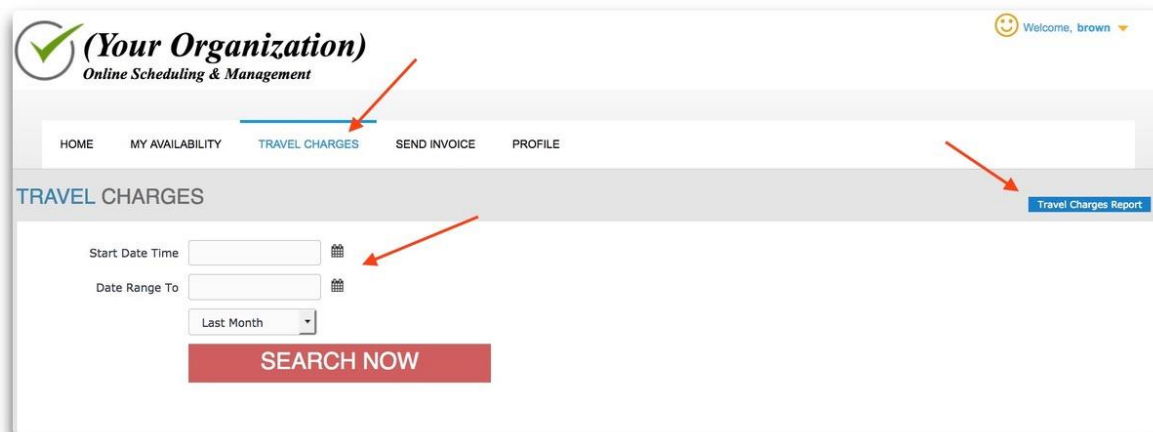
### Status I & II-1<sup>st</sup> Judicial Info
